PROGRAMME

August 21 - Saturday: FROM VENICE – departure h. 05.00 p.m.

Arrival at **Venice** port at h. 01.00 p.m. , registration on board. Accommodation . Welcome Buffet and dinner.

August 22 - Sunday: BARI h.10.00 a.m.- 03.00 p. m.

Full board on board. Arrival at **Bari**, the city is divided in two parts: the newest part expanded at the beginning of 1800 whilst the oldest shows the most important medieval and Renaissance monuments, among which the Romanic cathedral and the Romanic basilica of St. Nicola, Federico II 's castle and St. Ferdinando's Church.

August 23 - Monday: KATAKOLON (Greece) h. 08.00 a.m. - 01.00 p.m.

Full board on board. Arrival at **Katakolon**, a small port on the west coasts of the Peloponnesus, on the Ionian Sea. Katakolon is your gateway to **Olympia**, where the ancient Greeks flocked every four years for more than a millennium to celebrate the sacred games dedicated to Zeus. The ruins of the Sanctuary, with its athletic quadrangles, have stadium, temples and treasuries; the modern Archaeological Museum is a treasure house of Archaic, Classical and Roman sculptures, including the famous Niki Winged Victory.

August 24 - Tuesday: IZMIR (Turchia) h.09.00 a.m. -03.00 p.m.

Full board on board. Arrival at the island of **Izmir**, historically Smyrna, Turkey's third most populous city after Istanbul and Ankara and the country's second largest port city after Istanbul. It is located along the outlying waters of the Gulf of Izmir, by the Aegean Sea. The city is one of the oldest settlements of the Mediterranean basin. In Turkey this city is called Beautiful Izmir (Izmir gzel) for being situated along a long and narrow gulf, ploughed by ships and yachts.

August 25 - Wednesday: ISTANBUL (Turkey) h.07.30 a.m. - 05.00 p.m.

Full board on board. Arrival in Istanbul, one of the most beautiful cities in Asia and in Europe. It is located on the Bosphorus Strait and encompasses the natural harbour known as the Golden Horn, in the northwest of the country. It extends both on the European (Thrace) and on the Asian (Anatolia) sides of the Bosphorus, and is thereby the only metropolis in the world that is situated on two continents. The minarets of the many mosques, the Cathedral of Hagia Sophia (Saint Sofia), the Blue Mosque, the Golden Horn, the Bosphorus are some examples of the beauties of this city. A trip through the city is an unforgettable experience. The historic areas of Istanbul were added to the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1985.

August 26 - Thursday: at sea

Full board on board.

August 27 - Friday: DUBROVNIK (Croatia) h.11.30 a.m. -04.30 p.m.

Full board on board. Arrival in **Dubrovnik**, a Croatian city on the Adriatic Sea coast in the extreme south of Dalmatia. It is one of the most prominent tourist destinations on the Adriatic. The prosperity of the city of Dubrovnik has always been based on maritime trade. In the Middle Ages, also known as the fifth Maritime Republic (together with Amalfi, Pisa, Genoa and Venice), it became the only eastern Adriatic city-state to rival Venice. Supported by its wealth and skilled diplomacy, the city achieved a remarkable level of development, particularly during the 15th and 16th centuries. Among the many monuments the city offers, the finest Renaissance highlight is the Sponza Palace which is currently used to house the National Archives. The Rectors Palace is a Gothic-Renaissance structure that displays finely-carved capitals and an ornate staircase. It now houses a museum. Dubrovnik's most beloved church is St Blaise's church, built in the 18th century in honor of Dubrovnik's patron saint. In 1979, the city of Dubrovnik joined the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites.

August 28 agosto - Saturday: VENICE
